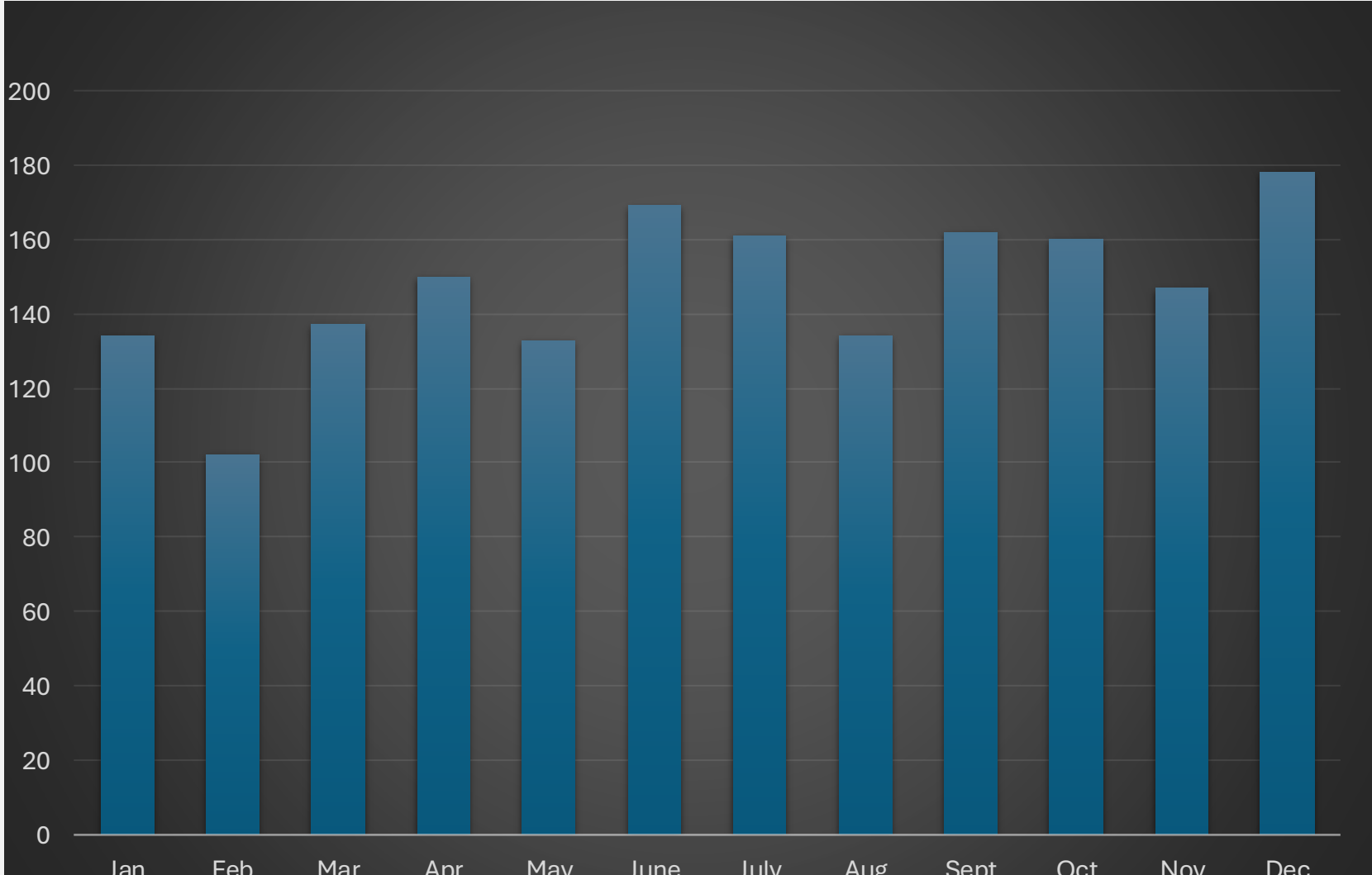

# Incidents by Month: 1767 Total



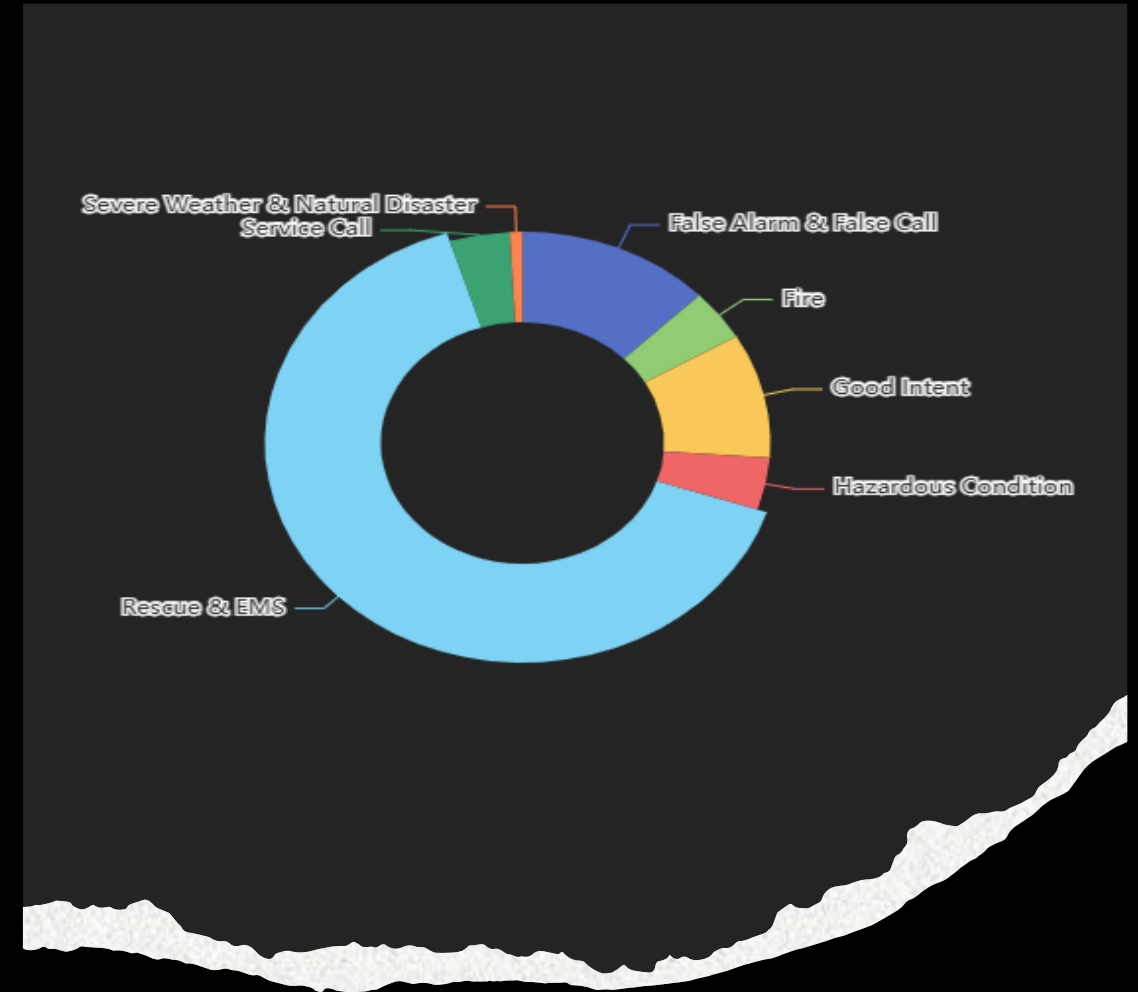
